Please abide by the Waste Hauler Permit Laws; do NOT haul more than 24 tires at any time. This limit will be enforced. Agricultural and Grove owners will be allowed to dispose of tires that have been illegally dumped on their property.

It is a violation of Florida Administrative Code rules to transport more than 24 waste tires over public highways without a permit. Violation of this rule would constitute a first degree criminal misdemeanor and be punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000 and/or by six months in jail.
