- Beat "A" had the highest occurrence of property crimes at 26%.



- \* Turning on outside porch lights.
- \* Close and lock garage door, and the door from the garage into the house.
- \* Remove valuables from your car, boat, and truck bed such as wallets, handbags, keys, and especially firearms.
- ★ Secure outside items such lawn equipment, toys, and bicycles.
