Civic Center Tennis Courts – New fencing and nets, complete resurfacing, and exterior lights for safety and security.



Richland Manor Courts – New tennis court and four pickleball courts with upgraded fencing.



Summerlin Park Basketball – New court surface and two new backboards.



Richland Manor Playground – New activity play structure for children 2 to 5 years of age.



Pittas Baseball Complex – New, brighter, and more energy-efficient LED light fixtures.



Mary Holland Main Entrance, RC Track, 555 Football Field, Baseball Fields – New, more attractive, and functional fencing.



Civic Center Kitchen – Full renovation, including new cooking and food service equipment.



Carver Recreation Center – Various overdue maintenance and safety improvements inside and outside of the facility to bring it up to modern standards and make it a place the community will want to gather.



Mary Holland Dog Park, MLK Gazebo Park, Gateway Park Restrooms, Mosaic Soccer Field – New ADA-compliant restroom facilities with a refreshing water fountain.



Richland Manor Park Restroom – New picnic pavilion where families can gather, along with new ADA-compliant restroom facility.



Civic Center Tennis Bleachers – New metal roofing and hurricane straps for safety, freshly painted bleachers for the audience.



Polk Street Community Center – New outdoor basketball systems (including poles, backboards, and rims) and improvements to baseball facilities, concession stand, and press box.



Mary Holland Park – Newly resurfaced tot playground, painting of the pavilions, and new picnic tables for outdoor meals.



Athletics Maintenance Building – Enclosure of old batting cage facility for maintenance and storage of turf maintenance equipment.
