PROJECT **OBJECTIVE**

To determine the development feasibility for a new downtown aquatics facility with the following components:

- Exercise, Activity & Recreation Pool
- 25 Yrd Exercise Lanes
- Zero-Depth Pool Entry
- Kids Pool with Play Structure
- "Splash Pad" Interactive Water Feature
- Shaded Event Pavilion
- Support Spaces/Structures for
 - > Lifeguards & Staff
 - > Concessions
 - > Restrooms
 - > Pump & Filter Equipment


















PROJECT SITE SELECTION

The 1.15 acre single-parcel site is immediately west of City Hall across N.
Wilson Avenue and home to the building originally constructed as the Bartow Civic Recreation Center and Pool between 1933-1935 under New Deal programs.

PROPOSED PROJECT SITE

The facility appears to have been unused since the Oaks School vacated the building in 2005 due to low enrollment and related financial hardships. Described by some as a blend of semi-Italian and Spanish architectural styles, structure was built of native stone and once featured a Spanish tile roof. The site has undergone multiple transformations and unrealized rehabilitation concepts. The building is not designated as a historically contributing structure by the National Register.

DESIGN VISION

The proposed concept aims to revitalize this locally significant site into a state-of-the-art community hub for recreation and wellness by creating a new aquatics facility Located within the downtown Bartow Community Redevelopment Area (CRA), the proposed Aquatics Center would honor the site's multifaceted history, from its New Deal origins to its educational and civic roles.




